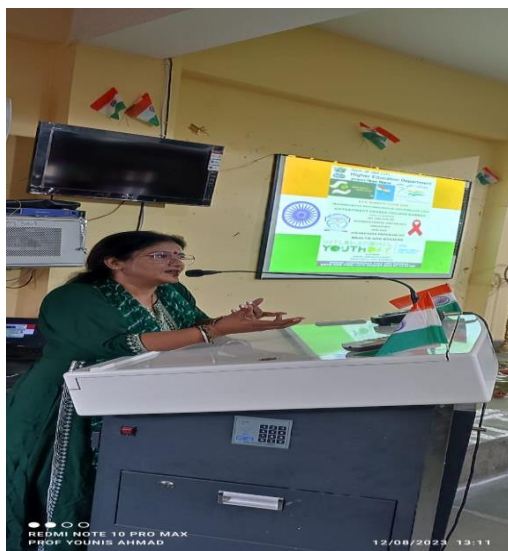



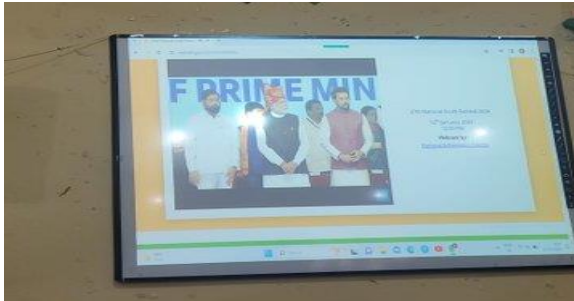
39. Fit India Week celebrated in GDC Ramban

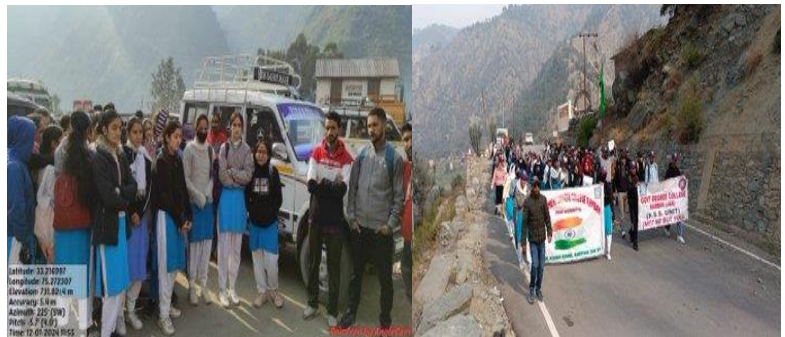
40. Live Telecast Of National Youth Festival Inauguration
